Getting an auction valuation

You can email pictures from your mobile phone to us and we can usually get back to you within a day, to give you an idea of value and suitability for the auction. This can help you choose what you decide to sell. Once we have seen the lot, we will confirm the guide price with you.

Plan your visit to the auction first

We will be accepting entries by appointment only during the week. You will need to contact us with an idea of what you have before you come, to avoid congestion at the saleroom and enable social distancing. Please do not arrive without a prior appointment. When you arrive the gate will be closed, but you can ring the bell and a member of staff will come to help direct you. We will be able to move your items for you once they are unloaded.

Collection

We are still able to offer collection as usual for larger consignments. We will book a time and day as normal in advance. We will be observing social distancing, to keep both staff and clients safe during this period. We can discuss your individual requirements with you before we attend and will make an assessment of your situation to ensure that social distancing can be maintained and is practical.
